

The 6th International Symposium on Meniere's Disease and Inner Ear Disorders



The 6th International Symposium on Meniere's Disease and Inner Ear Disorders took place over four days, from Sunday, November 14th to Wednesday, November 17th. A total of 400 individuals attended, including 200 individuals from 30 countries around the world and 200 participants from Japan.

The symposium serves as a venue for the presentation of research aimed at clarifying Meniere's Disease, the main cause of peripheral vertigo, and promoting therapeutic methods. Participants chose from among 300 presentations and enjoyed relaxing activities under Kyoto's autumn skies such as a visit to Kiyomizu-dera Temple and a gathering in the ICC Kyoto Garden, which helped to making this symposium fruitful and successful. The next symposium is scheduled to be held in five years in Italy.
