The International Symposium 2010 - East Asian Exchange as Seen Through Textiles - was held on Saturday, November 13th.

The symposium included a panel discussion and featured presentations by researchers from China, Korea, and Japan under the main theme of “Transmitting Robes, Linking Minds--The World of Buddhist Kasaya”. The event provided a venue for the sharing current research on medieval dyed textiles in each country and increasing understanding about the history of dyed textiles in East Asia. The symposium covered textiles in Sung, Yuan, and Ming Dynasties in China, from the Kamakura to Muromachi Period in Japan, and from the Goryeo Kingdom to the Joseon Dynasty in Korea.
