The Presentation Ceremony of the 2011 Kyoto Prize that is given to those who have made significant contributions to the progress of science, the development of civilization, and the enrichment and elevation of the human spirit, was held on 10th November. This year is the 27th since establishment of the Kyoto Prize. The Kyoto Prize, which is an international prize, is annually presented by the Inamori Foundation and consists of the following three categories; Advanced Technology (Dr. John Werner Cahn, age 83, U.S.A), Basic Sciences (Dr. Rashid Alievich Sunyaev, age 68, Russia, Germany), and Arts and Philosophy (Tamasaburo Bando V, age 61, Japan).
