

The 74th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japanese Circulation Society



March 26, 2010

The 74th Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japanese Circulation Society (JCS) was held on 5–7 March, 2010, with the main theme, "Exploring Uncharted Depths in Cardiovascular Medicine: Basic and Clinical Medicine Unified".

The JCS has over 30,000 members and its annual meeting is one of the biggest domestic meetings in Japan. Two marquees with 5,100m² in total were constructed in our first attempt, in which poster presentations, exhibitions, and reception desks were settled.

Dr. Toru Kita, the Congress Chairperson, with the program committee in the JCS and members in the Department of Cardiovascular Medicine, Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University built up the attractive program, so that the record-high 17,877 participants took part in the meeting.
