

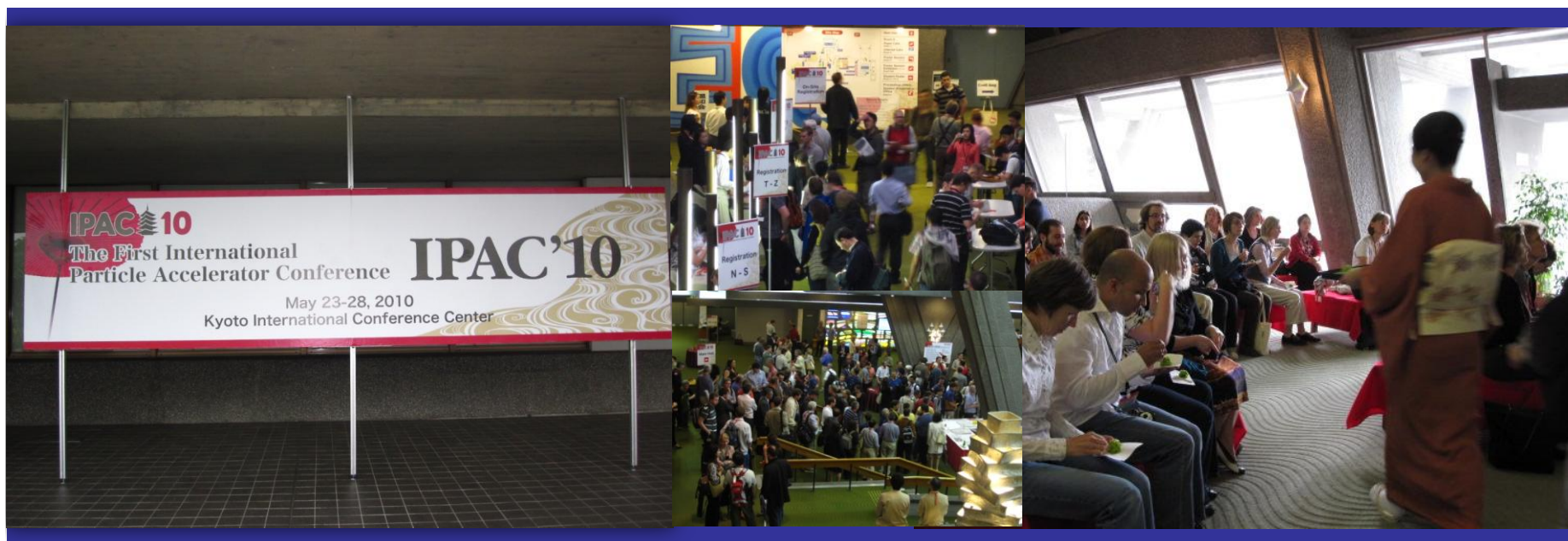
The 1st International Particle Accelerator Conference IPAC'10

The 1st International Particle Accelerator Conference was held in Japan on May 23–28. Researchers had lively discussion and workshops under the main theme of conference, with poster-sessions presented by students from around the world. In addition to the meeting, some cultural experience programs took place in the exhibition hall, such as live performance of traditional Japanese braid and fan. Participants were also able to enjoy the special tea ceremony between the sessions. On the final day, lectures about cancer treatment and pedestal physics in public program were given by Dr. Hirao, professor emeritus at the University of Tokyo, and Dr. Maskawa, who won Nobel Prize in Physics.

Ultimately, IPAC2010 closed with over 1,300 participants from 28 countries throughout the whole session.
