

# Food and Beverage Service Infection Prevention Guidelines

## (1) Banquet

### ①When entering

- A Customers are requested to wear a mask and disinfect their hands with alcohol when entering.
- B The organizer asks participants in advance to refrain from participating if they are feeling unwell, such as having a fever or cold symptoms.
- C When entering the banquet hall, please try to avoid crowds and keep a sufficient distance.

### ②Staff response

- A Staff take their temperature when they come to work, wear a mask, and always disinfect their hands with alcohol.

### ③About tables (seating)

- A When eating and drinking, if the distance between the seats next to each other is less than 1m and the distance between each other is less than 2m, we recommend setting up acrylic boards.

### ④Ventilation

- A We are working to ventilate the banquet hall by opening the windows on a regular basis.

### ⑤Infection prevention measures when providing food and drink

- A Designate the entrance and exit (one-way traffic) at the food table, etc., and regularly disinfect tongs that customers often touch. In addition, we will install gloves and alcohol-based hand sanitizer for customers.
- B We recommend wearing a mask when having a conversation while eating.
- C Regarding beverages, please refrain from pouring each other.
- D The food corner and bar staff will wear face shields or their masks and gloves.

\* We are responding to requests from the government, Kyoto Prefecture, and Kyoto City regarding banquets, food and drink service hours, and restrictions on alcoholic beverages.

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
